# The answers from the 6 worlds

Value the process before the result.

## GS • Bibou

Fireflies: 6, 9, 4. Words with B: BOAT, BALLOON, BANANA.

## CP • Plouf

Complements: 7, 3, 5. Sums: 7, 8, 6, 9, 8, 10. Path:  $2 \cdot 4 \cdot 6 \cdot 8 \cdot 10$ .

## CE1 • Léo

$47 + 36 = 83$ ;  $82 - 29 = 53$ ;  $65 + 18 = 83$ .  $4 \times 6 = 24$  mangoes.  $\cdot 3.70$ :  $\cdot 2 + \cdot 1 + 50c + 20c$ .

## CE2 • Astro

21; 24; 40; 27; 42; 36. Sequences: 20; 20 then 15; 32.

## CM1 • Rex

$236 \times 4 = 944$ ;  $408 \times 6 = 2,448$ ;  $175 \times 8 = 1,400$ .  $168 \div 7 = 24$ . Fraction equal to  $1/2$ :  $3/6$ .

## CM2 • Gauvain

$12.5 > 12.05$ ;  $7.80 = 7.8$ ;  $3.099 < 3.1$ ;  $45.6 = 45.60$ .  $P = 38$  m;  $A = 84$  m<sup>2</sup>. Future: I will cross, we will cross, they will cross. Puzzle: 24.73.



# Reading, games and support

Simple tips to keep the adventure going.



## READING

1. The stars don't shine anymore. 2. Examples: pearl, leaf, comet dust, volcanic stone, spark. 3. She's afraid to shine alone. 4. Personal answer: courage grows when we help each other.

## GAMES

Code: · = 5; · = 8; · = 2; total = 15. Mystery word: STAR.

## PREMIUM LITTLE RITUAL

Ask: 'What are you most proud of?' then pick one correction to explain together. Finish by colouring a star, even if it's not perfect.
